The Emilio Nares Foundation (ENF) announced today that it has received a grant from the KSWB Cares for Kids Fund, a fund of the McCormick Tribune Foundation. The ENF is a local San Diego County non-profit group that provides community services to families whose children have cancer. This grant, in the amount of \$5,000, will go to support the many vital ENF programs that help to ease the burden that comes to unwitting families who find themselves suddenly faced with the need to cope with life-threatening illnesses, and without the resources to meet the tremendous and overwhelming new demands.

Since its inception, the KSWB Cares for Kids Fund has donated more than \$16 million to local, children's charities.
