UPS/MBE AWARDS GRANT TO EMILIO NARES FOUNDATION UPS/MBE Helps Low-Income Families Whose Children Have Cancer

The Emilio Nares Foundation (ENF) announced today that they have received a grant from the San Diego-based MBE, a UPS company. MBE is the franchisor of The UPS Store and Mail Boxes Etc. ENF is a local San Diego County non-profit group that provides community services to families whose children have cancer. There are several ENF programs that help to ease the burden of unwitting families who find themselves suddenly faced with these life-threatening illnesses. They are without the resources to meet the tremendous and overwhelming new demands. This grant, in the amount of \$32,000, will go to support and expand a nutritional education program that provides cooking classes and meals for low-income families with children being treated at Rady Children's Hospital.

Founded by San Diego residents Diane and Richard Nares, the Emilio Nares Foundation (ENF) is a non-profit organization that provides medical information, support groups, respite care and transportation to families in San Diego County whose children have cancer. The heartfelt effort is in honor of their only son, Emilio, who was diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia at age 3 and lost his courageous battle with this dreadful disease shortly before his 6th birthday.
